
The Six Spiritual Maturity Levels (Cont'd)

The Six Spiritual Maturity Levels

1 The Community

The community is made up of everyone you have the potential to reach on a given Sunday. But for the most part, they are unchurched. They likely haven't decided to follow Jesus yet.

2 The Crowd

The crowd consists of all the people who attend Bayview on a regular basis. They consider themselves to be part of Bayview even if they haven't joined it yet. But they're not really involved beyond attending on Sundays.

3 The Congregation

The congregation includes everyone who attends and who has become a member of Bayview. These are people who attend regularly, give regularly, and support the vision and values of your church.

4 The Committed


These believers are not only members who attend, but they walk with God and are growing up spiritually. From our preaching calendar to the structure of our Impact groups, we must be intentional about creating pathways for people to grow from one level of commitment to the next.

5 The Core

Among the committed is people who get involved and serve others through the ministries of Bayview. The Core is generally those who give their time and their loyalty to Bayview.

6 The Commissioned

Our big goal for moving people from the community all the way to the core is ultimately to send them back out again to reach more of the community. When people are committed, growing, and serving, we should be preparing them to be sent out on missions. Then they become the commissioned.

Class 101 Discovering My Church Membership

Class 101 is a basic introduction to our church family and is designed to clearly explain who we are as a church. The sessions will cover Our Salvation, Our Statements, Our Strategy, and Our Structure.

Class 201 Discovering My Spiritual Maturity

Class 201 will help you develop the habits you need to jump-start your spiritual growth. It will give you an overview of the three basic spiritual habits every Christian needs in order to grow: Daily Time with God (prayer and Bible reading), Giving, and Fellowship.

These series of classes are designed to help you discover your church membership, spiritual maturity, ministry and your life mission.

Class 301 Discovering My Ministry

In Class 301 you will learn how God can use your **S**piritual Gifts, your **H**eart (passions), your Abilities, your **P**ersonality and your Experiences to minister (S.H.A.P.E.) to the needs of others. God gave you these gifts for you to use to build up His Church. God also gave you passion for particular activities and subject. Having the heart for specific things, people or circumstances is to be used to guide you into a ministry that you really care about.

Class 401 Discovering My Life Mission

God created you with a purpose. That personal, yet church-wide purpose, means connecting flawed human beings with our perfect and eternal God. Your life experiences can be a bridge to a friend or family member who is seeking Christ. God's global plan includes reaching people from every nation with the good news of Jesus. You'll also find out how you can be part of His local and global plan.
